MAKEABLES

As the name suggests, Makeables adds value to businesses with anything 'makeable' such as assembly, packing and finishing. Employees at our Makeables sites at Rocklea and Tingalpa perform a range of tasks including industrial assembly and pallet production, labelling, screen printing, boxing and bagging for a variety of businesses.

MONTE LUPO CAFE & COFFEE CARTS

Multicap's hospitality businesses serve more than 20,000 beverages this year from four locations across Brisbane - our coffee carts at Capalabla and Tingalpa, and our cafes at Eight Mile Plains and Banyo. Our employees gain experience in customer service, barista skills and managing transactions, as well as meal preparation, food delivery, baking and cooking, and food hygiene. Our Eight Mile Plains cafe doubles as a gallery, selling homewares and art pieces created in our Monte Lupo Arts Studio

LAUNDRETTO

Our Banyo and Capalaba Laundrettos are both full-service laundrettes. They offer fluff and fold, dry cleaning and ironing services all in the one location. Self-service options are also available. Our employees gain transferable experience in customer service and laundry skills.

MONTE LUPO ARTS STUDIO

Multicap established Monte Lupo in 1991 to provide creative employment solutions to artists with disability. Over the past 29 years, the clay products have been refined to ensure we can provide meaningful employment. Everyone in the studio is a valued team member and plays an important role in creating each piece, through creative collaboration. Our artists with disability have a combined 155 years of experience in the studio, with an average length of employment of nine years. Our team held five exhibitions this year and their art is for sale in the Monte Lupo cafe and via the Monte Lupo online store.

The Multicap/PepsiCo Partnership

CHALLENGE

PepsiCo required a cost-effective, high-volume co-packing solution with the ability to implement strict quality control processes and meet long-term growth requirements.

SOLUTION

PepsiCo partnered with Multicap at its bespoke warehouse in Tingalpa for an initial two-month trial. The trial involved establishing a production line on which products would be packaged, sealed, datestamped, quality inspected and packed for transport. Quantities of between 7 and 9 pallets (96 cartons on a pallet) are packaged each day.

Staff, including job coaches, supported employees and quality assurance, were trained in all aspects of the job with an emphasis on quality control.

OUTCOME

After a successful trial of outsourcing its packing requirements, PepsiCo has partnered with Multicap to package three product campaigns with the scope to grow to 10 over three years.

IMPACT

Employment opportunities for people with disability:

In the first year of the partnership, 30 supported employees will be required, growing to 100 in the second year and more than 200 in the third year.

Supported employees work with a job coach at varying ratios, from one supported employee per coach, to five supported employees with just one coach.

The goal is to build confidence and competence so that supported employees can work with greater independence, working towards open employment opportunities. "Everyone is trained in the process and what is required to meet 100 percent quality control on each job–PepsiCo has been impressed by our quality control. This quality control happens regardless of who the client is."
