

Transitional Accommodation Donegal House | Kuraby, QLD



Multicap's Donegal House accommodation offers a step-down community placement solution with wrap-around transitional supports for people with complex needs.

Service model

As part of Multicap's Critical Support Services, Donegal House is designed to provide short to medium term placements for people who require community placement along with an experienced, specialised multi-disciplinary support team. Whilst at Donegal St, Critical Support Services works with the person and their networks to develop an evidence-based support model that can be replicated and delivered safely and sustainably long term.

Important information

As Donegal House offers a transitional placement, typically funded under the NDIS' Short Term Accommodation and/or Medium Term Accommodation models, the service aims to support transition readiness to a person's long-term setting within six months from intake. All transitions will be planned and implemented based on individual customer needs, goals and values and with the input of their support networks.



Key Features

- Wheelchair accessible throughout, including two full wetrooms
- Four private bedrooms featuring courtyards, one featuring an ensuite
- One Overnight Active Assistance staff bedroom and office to facilitate 24/7 support models
- Multiple living and dining areas, including a spacious outdoor courtyard
- Close proximity to local health services and public transport
- Onsite vehicle allocated to the property
- Large fully fenced yard.

Who is this service for?

Donegal House is suitable for people experiencing a range of crisis situations, such as:

- a breakdown of service provision and subsequent risk of relinquishment and/or homelessness
- someone is in a clinical, forensic or prison setting and a lack of suitable accommodation and support options are preventing their transition back into the community
- an evidence-based support model to address complex needs has not been developed.
