Our volunteer opportunities

- **Community/One-on-one volunteers** - you are matched with a recipient in consultation with them and their family. The support you provide could be companionship or could provide respite to the recipient or their family. A few hours a month, you could hang out to watch a movie, have a coffee, go to a shopping centre, play games or head out for a walk, the options are endless.
- **Hub programs/Group outings (Student placement)** - you will support with group activities running in the Blackburn or Canterbury Hub and out in the community. We have program such as arts & crafts, music programs or day trips exploring Victoria. You could even facilitate a specialised group/activity that you are passionate about.

What we will ask of you

- Be ready to interact and support some amazing people working in line with Multicap requirements.
- Be reasonably confident that you'll be able to make the time available that you commit to.
- Attend relevant training if required and submit a regular record of your hours volunteered with us.

You will need to have the following to qualify for this role.

- Hold a Working with Children Check (Volunteer)
- A NDIS Worker Screening Check (Working with Individuals with Disabilities)
- Aged 18 years and over.

If you do not hold these checks, we can support you through the process.
